- 3. 95% of the reclaimable tax also benefits the Chaplaincy with 5% being deducted by the Diocese as an Administration Charge. For each £100 donated the Chaplaincy receives £23-75p in Reclaimable Tax and the Diocese £1-25p. NB: the Chaplaincy receives 100% of the donation.
