GREETING!

WHEREAS

- (i) The Constitution of the Diocese in Europe (“the Constitution”) provides that, subject to the provisions of the *Diocese in Europe Measure 1980* (“the 1980 Measure”) and of the Constitution and so far as the local law of any state or country shall permit, canons and other Ecclesiastical Law of the Church of England shall, so far as applicable, apply in the Diocese in Europe (“the Diocese”) with such modifications or exceptions as, on the submission of the diocesan Bishop after consultation with the Diocesan Synod, are deemed appropriate by the Archbishop of Canterbury acting with the concurrence of the vicar general of the Province and are specified in an instrument under the hand of the Archbishop;

- (ii) The Bishop of Gibraltar in Europe (“the Bishop”) after consultation with the Diocesan Synod of the Diocese in Europe has submitted to Us that the present instrument should be made in the form hereinafter appearing;

- (iii) The Vicar-General of the Province of Canterbury has concurred in the making of this Instrument

THIS INSTRUMENT PROVIDES THAT

1. Paragraph 3 of Amending Canon No. 29 shall not apply in the Diocese so that paragraphs 5 and 6 of Canon C12 thereby repealed shall continue to have full force and effect in relation to the grant and revocation by the Bishop of a licence to any minister in the Diocese
2. This Instrument shall come into force on such date as the Scheme embodying amendments to the Constitution and laid by the Bishop before the General Synod at its group of sessions in February 2020 shall come into force
