If a Chaplain/Priest-in-Charge wishes to invite a Baptised lay or Ordained member of another Church to perform this or any other liturgical duty for which the Bishop's Permission is required, the form APPLICATION FOR THE BISHOP'S PERMISSION UNDER THE ECUMENICAL CANONS should be completed and sent to the Suffragan Bishop.
