Opening our heart to God is an essential part of growing in faith and deepening our relationship with Him. But sometimes this journey (in faith) needs some encouragement and discernment.



People seek **spiritual direction** for many reasons. As Christians, we want to surrender our hearts to God and trust in His will for our lives. It might be to deepen and develop our Christian faith. It could be because we are struggling with our faith and need someone with whom to share our story and to stand with us as we work things through.

A spiritual director or “soul friend” does not “direct” in the sense of giving advice and solving problems. Rather, she or he helps a person respond to God’s invitation to a **deeper relationship**.



In this online session, diocesan advisors describe the nature of their ministry and explain how to find a spiritual companion.

You’ll hear from well-trained spiritual directors, have opportunities to discover more in breakout groups and, if you wish, find accompaniment for your own journey.
