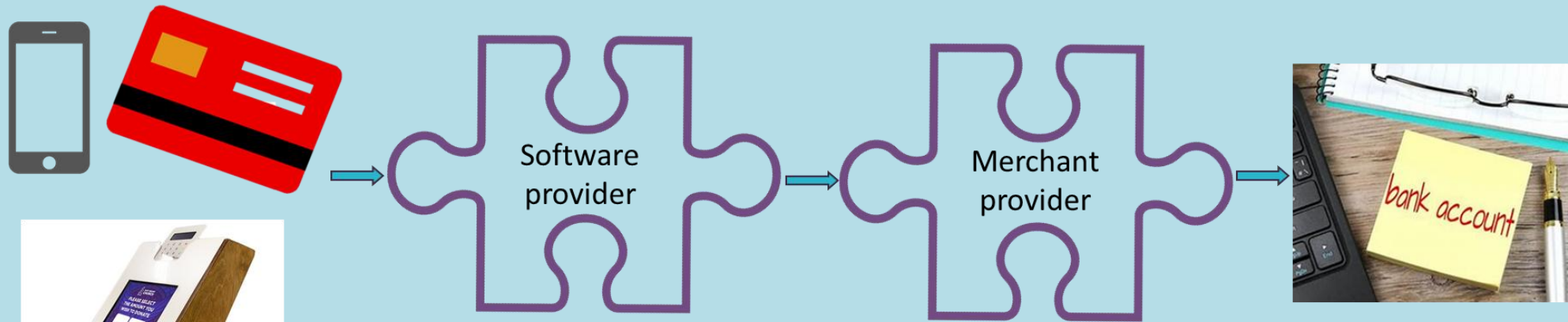

# Option 1 Devices



**Give A Little provides the 'interactive donor screen experience' (AKA the nice screen!)**



**Having both SumUp AND Give A Little means you are set up for both card reader AND online giving**

**SumUp processes the payments securely into the chaplaincy bank account**

# Option 1a: Payaz Giving Station

- Good for chaplaincies wanting something professional-looking and secure – for ‘self-service’ by the donor who can select or choose an amount to donate.
- Works with Wi-Fi or mobile signal.
- SumUp and Give A Little registration required.
- **Order via the Diocese.** Manufactured & shipped from Northern Ireland, meaning no/few VAT or customs issues.
- Dimensions: W233mm/H300mm/D267mm. Weight: c.6kg. 10 inch screen.
- Works via mains power or internal battery (up to 6 hours). Pre-installed security feature. Can also be secured via a ‘Kensington lock’ chain.
- The card reader and tablet can be taken out of the casing and used independently if you ever need a mobile option.
- Retail price incl. delivery = c.£420. Chaplaincy to pay £100.



# Option 1b: Payaz GO

- Good for chaplaincies wanting something professional-looking and portable – for ‘self-service’ by the donor who can select or choose an amount to donate.
- Works with Wi-Fi and mobile (a one-year European roaming SIM card will be installed in each device, so you can use it eg outside a church building). You can then decide if you want to renew the mobile data (or not) at a cost of c£60 per annum, or c£115 per two years. A SIM card has to be installed at the point of manufacturing as the device uses 3D casing. Note: you can’t swap the SIM card to a different one at a later date – because of the 3D casing.
- SumUp and Give A Little registration required.
- **Order via the Diocese.** Manufactured & shipped from Northern Ireland, meaning no VAT or customs issues.
- Dimensions: W135mm x D140mm x H310mm. Lightweight c1.5kg. 8 inch screen.
- Works via mains power or internal battery (up to 6 hours). Pre-installed security feature. Can be held or can sit on table. Can be secured with a ‘Kensington lock’ chain.
- Retail price incl. delivery = c.£320. Chaplaincy to pay £100.

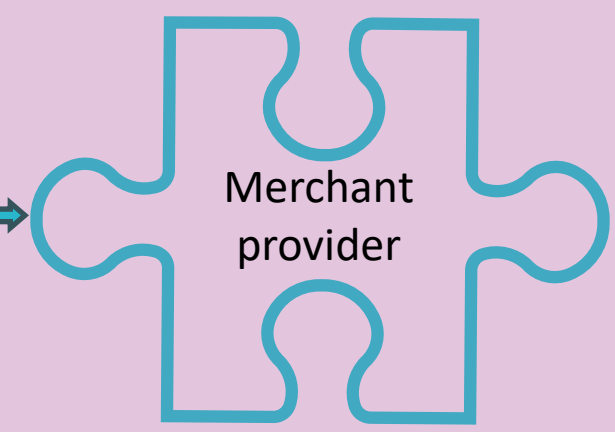


# Option 1c: CollecTin More

- Good for chaplaincies wanting something professional-looking and portable – for ‘self-service’ by the donor who can select or choose an amount to donate.
- Works with Wi-Fi and mobile.
- Order via the Diocese. Manufactured in mainland UK. If shipped to Europe, most countries will encounter customs and VAT. We can discuss this.
- Similar size to the PayazGO. Key advantage over the PayazGO model: You can open the casing and add your own mobile SIM card. It is also easier to swap the tablet/card reader in future.
- Works via mains power or internal battery (up to 6 hours). Pre-installed security feature. Can be held or can sit on table or you can add a wall mount. Can be secured with a ‘Kensington lock’ chain.
- Retail price incl. delivery = c.£360. Chaplaincy to pay £100.



# Option 2 Devices

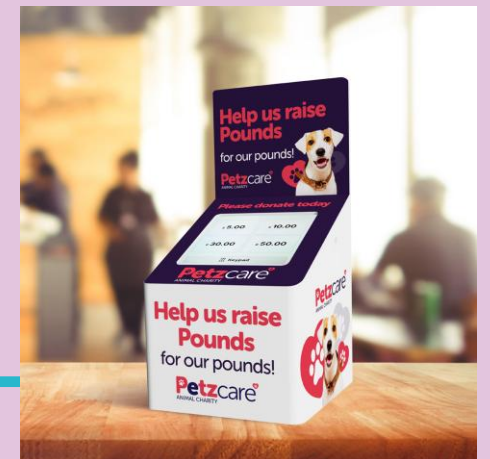


**SumUp processes the payments securely into the chaplaincy bank account**

Alongside the larger devices, we will also be offering these smaller devices, which are simpler to set up and operate. The devices use only SUMUP (not Give A Little). You can now create a basic QR code to enable a form of online giving.

# Option 2a: PayazTAPBOX

- Good for chaplaincies wanting something more visible than just the SumUp Solo.
- Works with Wi-Fi, plus **free** unlimited mobile data with **built-in** SIM card.
- Up to 8 hours of battery life, comes with a charging station.
- You should now be able to load up to four pre-set amounts with an option for the donor to type in their own.
- You can 'brand' the box. (If so, we'll get the template for you and probably easier to do that locally? TBC).
- **Order via the Diocese.** Manufactured & shipped from Northern Ireland, meaning no VAT or customs issues.
- Only SumUp needed, not Give A Little. And you can create a QR code just through SumUp.
- Dimensions = W95mm x D105mm x H190mm.
- Retail price incl. branding & delivery = c.£160.
- Chaplaincy to pay £60.

# Option 2b: SumUp Solo Device

- Good for chaplaincies wanting ‘something’; an entry-level device.
- Basically it’s the TapBox... without the box...
- Small, handheld device. Can’t be left unattended.
- Up to 8 hours of battery life, comes with a charging station.
- Retail price incl. delivery = c.£85 – **can be ordered directly from your local SumUp website** (but if you want to apply for a grant, you will still need to submit an application form *in advance!*)
- Chaplaincy to pay £40.



# Option 3: Alternative devices

- We may consider requests from chaplaincies to purchase other devices (eg a local solution or to buy elements separately – see pictures = tablet + SumUp Air + case or stand + security etc).
- **NEW FOR 2026:** Also in development are **Stripe devices** for Europe. (Stripe is a competitor to SumUp.) More details coming soon.



# Option 4: Offline devices **NEW FOR 2026**

- Options for churches with no or poor WIFI/mobile signal are in development & should be available soon.
