With over 250 congregations in more than 30 different countries, the Diocese in Europe is unique and flourishing. It has recently been allocated a significant grant from the Diocesan Investment Programme to develop further its ministry and mission over the coming years.

With so much going on in the Diocese, it is a great time to join the Friends. Members receive a quarterly prayer diary and newsletter. They are also invited to an annual service and reunion which takes place each autumn in London. This is an excellent opportunity to meet our bishops, diocesan staff and other members of the Friends.

There is no membership fee, but we do expect members of the Friends to give at least £30 annually. This is used to provide extra help in the Diocese for things like language training for the clergy and spouses, study grants, readers' scarves and supporting stipendiary curate posts.

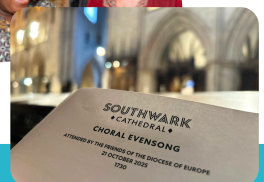
Our members come from a wide range of backgrounds. Many have lived and worshipped in the Diocese, and a number have served in it as clergy or in lay ministry.
